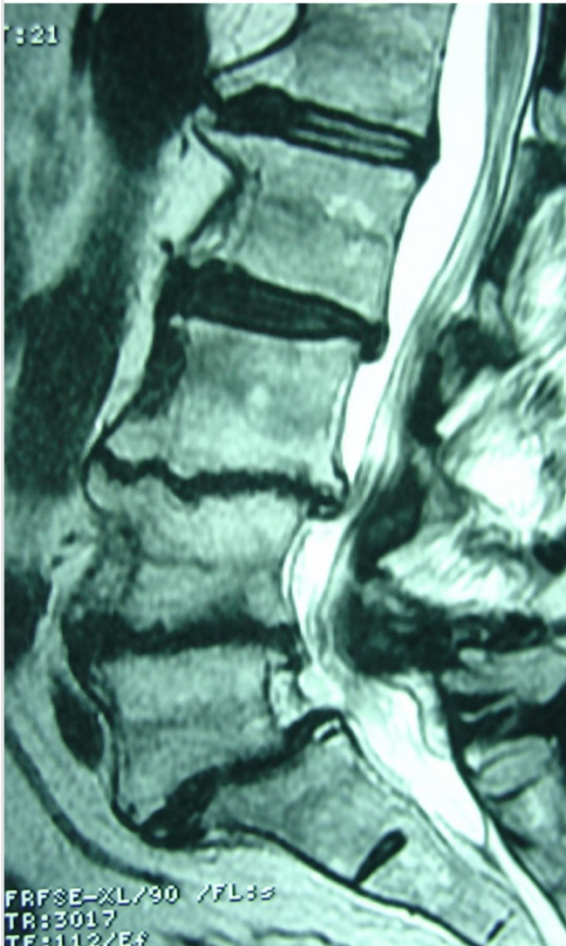




Spinal Stenosis Study



Our office is participating in a clinical data collection study from August 1, 2021, through December 31, 2021.

We are actively searching for patients diagnosed with **lumbar spinal stenosis**. (No compensation is given to patients or doctors participating in this study.)

Spinal stenosis concerns patients due to the pain and disability it brings. Chiropractic spine care treats this condition without surgery, and the success of this care needs research documentation.

The goal of the study is to determine **the number of treatments and days it takes, using Cox® Technic Flexion Distraction Decompression, to achieve maximum therapeutic benefit for these patients.**

Patients will be examined at visit 1 and asked to complete surveys of their pain and treatment response at visit 1, 4 weeks, 8 weeks, 6 months, and 12 months.
